Stocks, Options, & ETFs	
U.S Listed & OTC Securities (including ETFs) & Options	Commission-free trading refers to \$0 commissions for SoFi self-directed individual cash or margin brokerage accounts that trade U.S. listed and OTC securities (including ETFs), and options via the app or website.
American Depositary Receipts (ADRs)	Some ADRs are subject to custody fees. Fee information for a specific ADR may be obtained from that ADR's custodial bank.
Initial Public Offerings	\$50 for the first sale of a security obtained through an IPO offering within 120 days of IPO \$5 for each subsequent sale of a security obtained through an IPO offering within 120 days of IPO

Fund Fees	
Interval & Tender Offer Funds	Some specialized funds, like interval and tender offer funds, come with a transaction fee similar to a brokerage commission. If you buy one of these funds through SoFi Invest, a transaction fee of up to 2% of the purchase amount applies. The transaction fee that applies to a particular fund is shown on that fund's purchase screen before you place your order, and that displayed fee is the fee you will pay. This transaction fee is charged by SoFi Invest and is separate from the fund's own fees and expenses (such as its expense ratio and any sales charges), which are set by the fund and continue to apply in full. From time to time, SoFi Invest may, in its sole discretion, offer a reduced or promotional platform transaction fee (for example, 1% instead of 2%) on one or more funds for a limited period. A promotion may be limited to specific funds, specified account types (for example, IRAs only), one-time purchases, or a specified period. Any reduced fee applies only to SoFi



	Invest's own transaction fee and does not reduce or waive the fund's own fees and expenses. Mutual Funds	There are five basic types of mutual fund fees that may apply: • Front-end load fees: Charged by the fund when you purchase shares. This fee is deducted from your initial investment amount. • Back-end load fees: Charged by the fund when you sell or redeem your shares. • Contingent deferred sales charges (CDSC): A type of back-end fee that applies if you sell or redeem your shares within a specific time period. • Annual expenses (expense ratio): Ongoing fees charged by the fund to cover operating costs, including portfolio management, administration, distribution, and marketing. These fees are automatically deducted from the fund's assets. • Transaction fee: Charged by SoFi Invest on certain mutual fund purchases. This fee is 0.2% of the purchase amount and will not exceed \$20 per transaction. It's similar to a brokerage commission. You can find specific fee information in each fund's tearsheet and prospectus.
Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs)	If you invest in ETFs through SoFi Invest (either by buying them yourself or by investing in them through SoFi Invest's automated investments), these funds will have their own management fees. These fees are not paid directly by you, but rather by the fund itself. While most of these fees are very low, they do reduce the fund's returns and you should be aware of them. Check out each fund's prospectus for details. SoFi Invest does not receive sales commissions, 12b-1 fees, or other fees from ETFs for investing such funds on behalf of advisory clients, though if SoFi Invest creates its own funds, it could earn management fees there.
